Ski Buddy Program

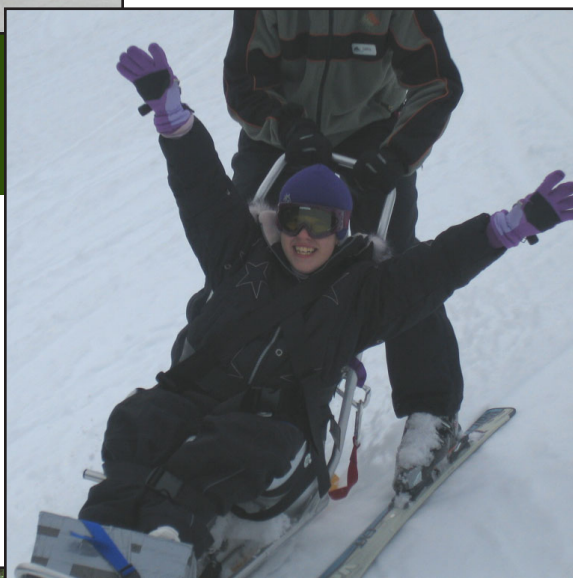
